We could have tried the matter before a SBOT Evidentiary Panel and it would have resulted in a private reprimand or possible dismissal. Six months of GRP and 2 extra hours of Ethics CLE was very doable, less expensive, and the matter dismissed after the probationary period. No record will remain. Given the cost of trying the Evidentiary Panel Case, this was a very positive outcome for the client and one that he eagerly embraced. You have to qualify for it but it is an excellent alternative to either an evidentiary panel or trial in district court.
